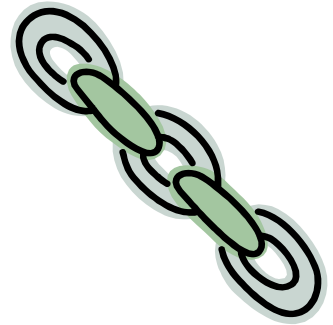

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM SYDNEY:** Take the F3 and head north towards Newcastle. Take the exit (slight left) onto Old Pacific Hwy (signposted as the Newcastle exit). Travel on the Old Pacific Hwy for 3.2 kilometres and then turn left onto Rutleys Road.

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM SINGLETON:** follow the New England Highway and go through Cessnock or Kurri Kurri until you get to Leggetts Drive. Follow Leggetts Drive to Freemans Waterhole, then follow Freemans Drive to the F3 entry. Join the F3 and travel to the Morisset exit. Take the Morisset exit and follow the signs to Morisset. Go straight through the first roundabout and turn right and the next roundabout on to Wyee Road. Follow Wyee Road for 5 kms and then turn left onto Rutleys Road.
